How the program works:

Successful candidates will undertake a 4-week (unpaid) training program commencing Tuesday 27th April where they will learn the baseline skills of an Aged Care Worker.

This program is broken down into 2 weeks of class-based training, followed by 2 weeks of work placement (unpaid) where they will be mentored and supervised by an experienced Aged Care Worker.

Upon successful completion of the 4-week recruitment program, all participants will be issued with a nationally accredited Statement of Attainment for the following 4 units of competency;
