How the program works:

Selected participants will undertake a 3 week (unpaid) training program starting **Tuesday 17th August 2021**.

The program is broken down into face to face training and an unpaid work placement over a period of 3 weeks, where you will be mentored and supervised by an experienced care worker. Upon successful completion of the program, participants will be issued with a nationally accredited Statement of Attainment for the following three units of competency;

- *HLTWHS002 Follow safe work practices for direct client care.*
- *HLTINF001 Comply with infection prevention and control policies and procedures*
- *CHCCCS015 Provide individualised support*

Opal HealthCare will then confirm the candidates who will join their team under a traineeship model and complete the nationally accredited qualification - **CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support** whilst remaining in paid employment.

To be eligible you must meet the following criteria:

- not already have the CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual support
- be 18 years or older and no longer at school
- be an Australian or New Zealand Citizen or permanent resident
- live or work in NSW
- be willing to get the latest flu vaccination
- be willing to undergo a national Police Background Check
- be willing to undergo a NDIS Worker Check prior to employment.
