How the process works

Selected participants will undertake a 3 week (unpaid) training program starting **Tuesday 24th August 2021**.

The program is broken down into face to face training and an unpaid work placement (15-20 hours) over a period of 3 weeks, where you will be mentored and supervised by an experienced care worker.

Upon successful completion of the program, participants will be issued with a nationally accredited Statement of Attainment for the following three units of competency;

- HLTWHS002 Follow safe work practices for direct client care.
- HLTINF001 Comply with infection prevention and control policies and procedures
- CHCCCS015 Provide individualised support

Whiddon Aged Care and Connectability Aust will then confirm the participants who will join their team under a traineeship model and complete the nationally accredited qualification - CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support, whilst remaining in paid employment.

There is no cost associated with this program - This training is subsidised by the NSW Government.

To be eligible you must meet the following criteria:

- not already have the CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support
- be 18 years or older and no longer at school
- be an Australian or New Zealand Citizen or permanent resident
- live or work in NSW
- be willing to get the latest flu vaccination
- be willing to undergo a national Police Background Check
- be willing to get to COVID vaccination if it becomes a requirement
