How the program works:

Successful applicants will undertake a 4-week (unpaid) training program commencing Tuesday 25th May where they will learn the baseline skills of a Support Worker.

This program is broken down into 2 weeks of class-based training, followed by 2 weeks of work placement (unpaid) where you will be mentored and supervised by an experienced support Worker at one of the respective organisations.

This is your opportunity to shine!

Upon successful completion of the 4-week recruitment program, all participants will be issued with a nationally accredited Statement of Attainment for the following 5 units of competency;

- CHCDIS007 Facilitate the empowerment of people with disability
- CHCDIS001 Contribute to ongoing skills development using a strengths-based
- CHCDIS003 Support community participation and social inclusion
- CHCDIS002 Follow established person-centred behaviour supports
- HLTINF001 Comply with infection prevention and control policies and procedures.

Our employers will then choose up to 16 candidates to join their teams under a permanent part-time contract (traineeship) where you will complete the full qualification - CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support (Disability) whilst being in paid employment.
