How the program works

Selected participants will undertake a 3 week (unpaid) training program starting **Tuesday 21st September 2021**.

The program is broken down into trainer led training sessions (delivered via MS Teams) and an unpaid work placement (15-20 hours) over a period of 3 weeks, where you will be mentored and supervised by an experienced care worker. Work experience will not commence until the NSW regional lockdown has ended.

Upon successful completion of the program, participants will be issued with a nationally accredited Statement of Attainment for the following three units of competency;

- HLTWHS002 Follow safe work practices for direct client care.
- HLTINF001 Comply with infection prevention and control policies and procedures
- CHCCCS015 Provide individualised support

NovaCare will then confirm the participants who will join their team under a traineeship model and complete the nationally accredited qualification - CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support, whilst remaining in paid employment.

There is no cost associated with this program - This training is subsidised by the NSW Government.

To be eligible you must meet the following criteria:

- not already have the CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support
- be 18 years or older and no longer at school
- be an Australian or New Zealand Citizen or permanent resident
- live or work in NSW
- be willing to get the latest flu vaccination
- be willing to undergo a national Police Background Check
- be willing to undergo an NDIS Worker Screening Check
- be willing to get a COVID vaccination if it becomes a requirement
