The organisation provides services to clients in the Newcastle/Lake Macquarie Region.

How the program works

Selected participants will undertake a 2 week training program starting Monday 7th March 2022.

The program is broken down into trainer led workshops and an unpaid work placement over a period of 2 weeks, where you will be mentored and supervised by an experienced support worker.

Upon successful completion of the program, participants will be issued with a nationally accredited Statement of Attainment for the following three units of competency;

- HLTAID011 Provide first aid
- CHCMHS001 Work with people with mental health issues
- DFAADF001 Provide first aid to a person with a disability

Participating organisations will then confirm the participants who will join their team and complete the nationally accredited qualification - CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support, whilst in paid employment.

There is no cost associated with this program - This training is subsidised by the NSW Government.

To be eligible you must meet the following criteria:

- not already have the CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support
- be 18 years or older and no longer at school
- be an Australian or New Zealand Citizen or Permanent Resident
- live or work in NSW
- transport and drivers licence required
- COVID vaccination completed
- be willing to undergo a national Police Background Check
- be willing to undergo an NDIS Worker Screening Check
